Engage Men and Boys (EMB) network is the country network in Bangladesh associated with MenEngage Alliance Global and South Asia, with around 42 members (Civil Society organizations and Individual Activists) across Bangladesh. Save the Children (SCI) is an elected secretariat of the network for two years (2019 & 2020).

**SRHR for All Project** (funded by MenEngage Global Alliance) is a designed in South Asia regional network and five country level networks. In Bangladesh, the project is jointly designed and is aiming to implement together with members of the EMB network and the network supported 'Youth Platform for Transforming Masculinities'. Youth will be capacitated in caring masculinities behaviors', especially around SRHR and child marriage. This project will be led by Youth change maker in particular under the close supervision of SCI, EMB Secretariat and Steering Committee. Three (3) youth leads will be recruited as volunteers for the project period.

#### A. Summary of Key Functions:

- Engage and capacity strengthening of 100 Youth to ensure effective youth lead advocacy movement at national and community level on SRHR for All and End Child marriage to challenge stigma, discrimination, attitudes and laws from masculinity perspective.
- Develop Communications and evidence based advocacy related actions on SRHR and End Child Marriage Issues, with counterparts, policy makers, civil society organizations and the community people
- Build strategic partnerships and support to the implementation of the SRHR for All and End Child Marriage
- Ensure social media campaign to promote SRHR for all;
